

## **Band Booster Meeting 10/4/07 - 7:00 P.M.**

### **Treasurer's Report**

- Current balance: \$4,903.26 + \$1,000 (cash) & \$75 (coins) reserved for CFMS concessions
- No Raymond James checks received yet for events on 9/16 & 9/23. Anticipate approximately \$1,200 - \$1,300 for each event. Mr. Revett will check with KHS office that receives the checks.
- Recent payment made include: \$166 for balance on bus fees for 2006-07 school year, McCormick's for shoes, and payment to Mr. Abraham.
- Still waiting on bill for shorts and 2<sup>nd</sup> set of t-shirts that were ordered.

### **Central Florida Marching Band Showcase October 13<sup>th</sup>**

- Call time – 11:00 AM. First band will arrive around 3:15 PM (show begins at 4:00 PM)
- Mr. Revett will assign the students jobs, and students will get food ½ off (once everything is ready & for the rest of the day).
- Have 5 bands that will be coming (have payment from all except one) approx. 450 band students.
- First band will perform at 4:10 with rest of bands to follow at 20 minute intervals. Awards at 7:00 PM. Rain plan is to move show into the gymnasium.
- Not much is left to spend money on for this event (other than food for the concession stand and judges fees - 6 judges @ \$200/judge & possibly mileage @ .45/mile).
  - Need to purchase 5 DVDs for copies of the show for each director. Cannot sell DVDs of show without paying for rights of each individual song, but can give them to directors.
  - Mr. Revett found awards (brand new plaques) that were purchased for a past show but never used; will only need to purchase 6 metal plates at approx. \$8.00 each.
  - Need to purchase batteries (approx. \$30), wrist bands or stamp and name tags.
- **Concessions** –
  - We will have our regular football game menu.
  - Concession stand menu with prices is needed for program (Dave Thomas will provide).
  - Mr. Revett will check with Michelle regarding using the slushy machine.
  - Mr. McClelland is getting the band 20 cases of soda to replace what was stolen last year.
- **Programs** – Mr. Revett has the program just about all ready to go.
  - He has received the bios from the bands that will be coming & also requested pictures.
  - A number of sponsors have purchased ads: (2) \$150 full page, (2) \$100 ½ page, (2) \$25 business card size. Dave Thomas also has (1) more full page & (3) business card size.
  - County print shop will print programs – needs everything all ready to go by tomorrow in order to programs ready by next Friday, 10/12. Mr. Revett to call Kevin at the print shop to see if this deadline can be extended to Monday, 10/8.
- **Transportation** –
  - Susie Perry & Jeff Spencer can provide trucks & trailers.
  - Carolyn Smith also has a truck available if needed & Cherie Bowden has a flatbed trailer.
  - Mr. Revett is going to ask about using Ag's tractor.
- **Parking** – Mr. Revett requested 6-8 ROTC students to help with parking (has not heard back yet).
- **Pictures** - The picture company that was at the Leesburg competition will also be coming. KHS band will receive 10% of the sales of pictures from our event.
- **Food - Directors & Judges** – The Band boosters will provide a potluck dinner (in the press box) for the visiting judges, band directors and their staff (approx. 35 people).

## **OTHER UPCOMING EVENTS:**

- Friday, October 9<sup>th</sup> – **Away game George Jenkins** , Call time 5:00 PM, Return 11:00 PM
- Saturday, October 6<sup>th</sup> – **Heritage Parade** – Call time 12:00 PM at Texas Cattle Company. Parade by Lake Mirror. Should be finished by 1:15 PM. Event coordinators will provide water. Band t-shirts & black shorts (will not wear uniforms). **Thanks for coming!!!**
- **Band pictures** have been rescheduled for next Thursday, October 11<sup>th</sup>.
- **La NouBa Show** – Friday, October 26<sup>th</sup> (show time 6:00 PM, must arrive by 5:00 PM)
  - Tickets came out to \$44.00 each – Mr. Revett has ordered 70 (includes 10 adults who have already confirmed). Payment needs to be sent overnight to secure seats. Estimated cost from booster funds is \$2,600.
  - Students must have band fees paid in order to go (approx. 15 student fees not fully paid)**Wednesday the 10<sup>th</sup> Deadline!!!**
  - Bus - \$10 fee for everyone riding the bus. Students must ride the bus. School buses cannot guarantee to be ready for us to leave by 4:00 PM. We will investigate cost for a charter bus (would rather do this than school buses). Alisha Housley will speak with Athletic Dept. to see if they get a special rate (also capacity) on charter buses they use.
  - Dinner after show – Downtown Disney. Chorus has gone to Hardrock Café where they offer dinner (with gratuity) for only \$12 (limited menu). Everyone agreed that this would be a good idea for dinner.
  - Patty Goddard made a motion to use band booster funds to pay for the tickets for the students to attend the La NouBa show. Motion was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Chris Housley. All in favor.

## **OTHER ITEMS:**

- Music – Jazz, & Concert Band – Mr. Revett would like to purchase several pieces for Jazz & Concert Band; he has checked with all Polk County schools and none own the pieces he is looking for. Approximate cost is \$200.
